Midget Mumblings

A while back, I wrote complaining about how the engine vibrations were transmitted into the passenger compartment and wondered if better motor mounts might isolate more of them. In case you have been holding your breath till I answered that question, you can exhale now. I had to pull the engine out of the car and while doing so, a bit of mission creep set in. One of the things I decided to add to my workload was replacing the mounts. That job is fairly easy with the engine out and a real witch with a capital B when the engine is in place. I ordered new front and rear mounts from British Parts Northwest and waited for delivery. While I waited, I discovered the vertical brackets that connect the front mounts and the chassis had cracked in two from age and vibration. Using my ultra cheap welder, I managed to weld them back together. My welds ain't pretty, but nobody can see them and I shot some black paint over them anyway.

When the new mounts arrived, I compared them to the old ones. On the old ones, the rubber was so hard I could not press my thumbnail into it. The new ones were considerably softer. Based on this highly scientific test, I concluded the new ones would be much more compliant and absorb more of those nasty engine vibrations. The whole purpose of having rubber in the mounts is for them to flex a bit and soak up vibrations. Rubber that is brick hard will soak up about as much vibration as a brick will.

Once the engine was reinstalled, I drove the car and indeed, there is less harshness and vibration. Of course, I did replace the extra high compression engine that had an up-rated cam with my spare bone stock motor. Perhaps the extra smoothness I am feeling is not all due to the softer mounts. But I bet some of the improvement is.

Were my old mounts of inferior quality when I bought them a decade or two back? Maybe. The original design specs called for a specific rubber hardness, but the quality control of aftermarket parts often made in third world countries is suspect. Or did the rubber just harden with age and exposure to heat and oil? If you haven't checked your mounts lately, you might want to see if they have ripped or sagged and give the rubber the thumbnail test. These were never expected to last forever. And if you do buy new ones, check to see that they aren't brick hard before you go to the trouble of installing them.
